



# Food Programs

## 1. FOOD PANTRY

**What:** Neighbors may receive a 10 day supply of food from the Food Pantry each month.

**When:** Monday - Friday  
9:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.

Please arrive by 3:30 p.m.

Pantry closes at 6:00 p.m. on Thursdays.

**Where:** The Caring Place - Food Pantry  
2000 Railroad Avenue

**How:** Visit reception at our Food Pantry and you will only need to self-declare your income and live in our service area to receive food benefits.

## 2. FRESH FOOD FOR FAMILIES

**What:** Neighbors may receive a variety of fresh produce up to three times a month.

**When:** 1st, 3rd and 5th Monday of the month  
9:00 a.m. - 9:45 a.m.

**Where:** The Caring Place - Drive Through  
at south side of building at 2000 Railroad Avenue

**How:** By car, use the drive through on south side of building. Walk-ups may use the warehouse entrance in parking lot at north side of building. Anyone from any area may participate in Fresh Food for Families. There are no eligibility requirements

## 3. OUR DAILY BREAD

Sponsored by HEB

**What:** Neighbors may take one bread item and one pastry item in The Caring Place lobby during Food Pantry business hours. There are no eligibility requirements for this program.
