1. FOOD PANTRY

What: Neighbors may receive a 12 day supply of food from the Food Pantry each month.

When: Monday - Friday
9:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.

Please arrive by 3:30 p.m.

Pantry closes at 7:00 p.m. on Thursdays.

Where: The Caring Place - Food Pantry
2000 Railroad Avenue

How: Visit reception at our Food Pantry and you will only need to self-declare your income and live in our service area to receive food benefits.

2. FRESH FOOD FOR FAMILIES

What: Neighbors may receive a variety of fresh produce up to three times a month.

When: 1st, 3rd and 5th Monday of the month
9:00 a.m. - 9:45 a.m.

Where: The Caring Place - Drive Through
at south side of building at 2000
Railroad Avenue

How: By car, use the drive through on south side of building. Walk-ups may use the warehouse entrance in parking lot at north side of building. Anyone from any area may participate in Fresh Food for Families. There are no eligibility requirements.

3. OUR DAILY BREAD

Sponsored by HEB

What: Neighbors may take one bread item and one pastry item in The Caring Place lobby during Food Pantry business hours. There are no eligibility requirements for this program.
